

Meeting in Vilnius October 2015



The project meeting began at the Lithuanian “teacher’s day” with a very friendly salutation by the Lithuanian teachers. Flowers were given to the project group and to the teachers of the school. The highlight of the opening ceremony were Lithuanian folksongs sung by the teachers.



After the opening ceremony the project work started with the presentation of the ten different schools.



Afterwards we built internationally mixed working-groups of students and teachers to work on the experimental protocols. Both, the students and the teachers experimental instructions were translated from English into all the languages of the partner schools. Other working-groups were working with our e-Twinning- and project-website and published the first project results.



The working in the school was supplemented by a visit of the biomass plant in Vilnius and the Lithuanian institute for energy in Kaunas. There we learned from the scientists that the amount of renewable energy in Lithuania has already reached 23 % of the total energy consumption, so Lithuania is already 3 % above the EU goals for 2020.



Beside the lovely social gathering, our hosts also prepared cultural highlights for us: A visit at the historical university of Vilnius, the museum of the victims of the genocide, the catacombs of the cathedral, the monastery Pažaislis and the open-air museum in Kaunas where the students enjoyed playing traditional games.
